



Activities of the Junior Campus

Entry Test and Interviews

Entry Test for new admissions in Classes Prep and 5 were held on Dec 16, 2017. The exam centres for written test were set at Abbottabad, Lahore, Karachi, Quetta and Multan. Many contestants from all over Pakistan came to take the test. 231 applicants appeared for Prep while 67 applicants appeared for Class-5. After the written test, the qualified students appeared for interview from January 09-13, 2017 at Abbottabad centre and from January 22-26 at Lahore centre. The selection was totally based on merit.
