• Shifting from Conventional to E-learning Teaching

The College intends to shift its teaching from conventional to E-learning

style for which all class rooms have been installed with Interactive Boards /LEDs. A workshop in this regard was conducted, with the help of Punjab Information Technology Board (PITB), to train the teachers to modify their teaching with live images of the concepts they teach from



the books. The new development will prove very fruitful in understanding the difficult concepts and will make the process of teaching very interesting.



• The Concept of Day Boarder

ABHC for Boys functions as a classic boarding/day scholars' public academic institution accommodating students from class Prep to F Sc & Pre JC-1 to A Level. The College has a rich legacy and culture of developing a wholesome personality of its students through mental, social and physical education. It has excellent infrastructure for outdoor and indoor sports, but being utilized by the Boarders only, whereas the bulk of the students are Day Scholars. At present, the college strength is going with 71:29 ratio of Day Scholars and Boarders.

An idea of enrolling the students as Day Boarders was launched in 2019 for 1st year students with the view that maximum students utilize the sports and mess facilities, very rarely available in other academic institutions of Abbottabad. The idea could not become popular among parents due to certain flaws and the concept fizzled out gradually.

The same concept has been launched again with more deliberate and meticulous planning. The option has been extended to higher and lower classes both. These Day Boarders will avail all facilities like Boarders till Maghrib Prayer and leave the College by evening. The option will be open for the students residing in the Abbottabad city. A good number of students have opted and joined.















Commencement of Online Classes

The College has introduced online studies to keep the light of knowledge illumine the souls amidst the dark days of prevailing COVID-19. All the classes from junior most to senior most have been engaged via Whatsapp's & Zoom Cloud Meeting as a ray of hope to overcome the odds in the way of progress. The students are



instructed in the best possible way and are encouraged to attempt the home assignments to reinforce the concepts taught. Though online education can never take the place of classroom teaching yet it has its own advantages and has proved to be a blessing to prevent the wastage of time and talent.
