Results of SSC-I & II

In SSC Part-II Exam, 209 students appeared. 72 students secured A1 & 72 students secured A grade. Muhammad Hamza Abdullah obtained 1007 marks out of


1050 marks and stood 1st. He secured the highest ever marks of this great institution.

In SSC Part-I Exam, 179 students appeared. 101 students secured A1 & A grades. 150 students have obtained 1st division. Student Hassan Abdullah stood 1st, by securing 475 marks out of 495 with the percentage of 95.96.



Results of HSSC-I & II and Cambridge

This year the hardworking and dedicated students devoted themselves whole heartedly to study and produced the ever best results in the HSSC Part I & II. The Principal, Brig Mukhtiar Muhammad, contributed an earnest effort to achieve academic excellence. Under his able guidance the devoted faculty sweat and burnt the midnight oil to add a feather in the cap of Burn Hall.



In HSSC Part-I, 199 students appeared. Out of these, 103 students got A1 and A grades. Danish Ali Khan of class first year stood 1st, by securing 471 marks out of 505.

In O-Level Exam, 27 students appeared and all of them passed. The total number of A* & A grades obtained by the students are 77. It is important to note that A* starts from 90% and above marks & A grade from 80% & above. Muhammad Saad Tahir has obtained 7 A* & 1 A, whereas, Abdullah Wahadan has secured 4 straight As, which are the highest ever grades secured by a student in the aforesaid exam so far.









20th All Pakistan Burn Hall Bilingual Declamation Competition, 2016
